## **SEPTEMBER IS DIGITAL EQUITY MONTH IN NCW**

### **-Several initiatives to raise awareness in NCW-**

**Wenatchee, WA-** The NCW Tech Alliance, Thriving Together NCW, and the NCW Digital Access and Equity Coalition have coined **September as Digital Equity Month in NCW**. In celebration and effort to raise awareness about the importance of digital equity, there will be a series of events, resources, programs, and initiatives reaching residents in Chelan, Douglas, Okanogan, and Grant counties.

Launching in September, Digital Equity Month will offer community members access to digital resources, skills, and refurbished computers. It will also offer organizations the opportunity to enhance their digital navigation skills to better serve members of our community that are struggling to navigate the digital world.

Digital Equity is “*a condition in which all individuals and communities have the information technology capacity needed for full participation in our society, democracy, and economy,*” according to the National Digital Inclusion Alliance. “At NCW Tech Alliance, we believe that living where you love shouldn't limit potential. For over two decades, we've championed digital equity in our region, and the journey continues. Recognizing the hurdles many face—from infrastructure to skills—we're committed to leveraging technology as a catalyst for change, ensuring everyone has access and the capability to thrive,” stated Jenny Rojanasthien, Executive Director of NCW Tech Alliance.

To raise awareness and offer support during **Digital Equity Month in September**, there will be a series of tools developed for community-based organizations (CBO) to use and distribute, as well as opportunities for people experiencing the digital divide:

- **Digital Navigator Trainings:** The North Central Education Services District will be leading Digital Navigator Trainings across the region. These train-the-trainer models are designed to equip participants with the knowledge and skills to become trusted Digital Navigators. Training will cover technology and telehealth basics and participants will gain insights on how they can help community members learn about web browsers, signing up for email, online portals, and more. Trainings are free and open to the public but require advance registration:

- **NCW Tech Help Resources:** A comprehensive collection of information, tools, and resources that offers quick, one-stop support navigating the digital landscape and helps get individuals online. A printed and electronic guide will be available in English, Spanish, Russian, and Ukrainian. Included will be a series of videos to help inform community health advocates and communities on how to utilize telehealth and technology resources.
  - **NCW Tech Help Learning Labs and Technology Classes:** Trained Digital Navigators will be hosting pop-up Tech Help events across four counties to assist individuals with various technological needs. They can provide guidance on connecting online, finding a local Internet provider, and explaining the concept of telehealth. Tech Help booths will be available starting August 24 during the NCW Fair in Waterville. Please watch for the upcoming dates and locations in NCW. In addition, NCW Tech Alliance will be teaching six technology classes at CAFE in Spanish from September 11 to September 28.
  - **NCW Digital Access and Equity Coalition:** The NCW Digital Access and Equity Coalition will officially launch on September 28 at 3:00pm. Stakeholders in this collaborative effort will address issues related to digital access and equity across Chelan, Douglas, Grant, and Okanogan counties. CBO's participating in the coalition will be offered assistance to help their organization incorporate digital equity into their strategic plans and help address the critical gaps across the region.
