THANK YOU JENNY ROJANASTHIEN

On November 8, we celebrated Jenny Rojanasthien as she moved from the leader of our organization into a part-time role. During her eight years as Executive Director, Jenny transformed our organization into a regional powerhouse. Under her leadership, NCW Tech Alliance organized over 200 high-caliber events benefiting more than 15,000 individuals. Jenny is a founding member of the Apple STEM Network, which now serves 29 districts. Jenny founded the Flywheel Investment Conference, which showcases NCW as a vibrant place for startups to thrive and has resulted in millions of dollars in investment. Jenny forged a partnership with Microsoft and through Project iLumina, launched a rural resiliency and inclusion strategy, impacting lives across our region. She also brought the Community Skills Initiative program to ten locations across the country. Our board and staff are grateful for the years of service Jenny has given to our organization.

Jenny shared, "Leading NCW Tech Alliance has been the highlight of my career. Dr. Sue Kane is the perfect leader to carry the torch and I'm excited to see the organization thrive under her." Adding "I'm not completely gone either! I'll be working under Sue to support entrepreneurial programs - and I look forward to seeing NCW Tech Members in 2024!

45+ EVENTS

NCW Tech Alliance hosted an incredible 45 events in 2023 and partnered on dozens of others. From Industry Tours to Cyber Meetups, an Al Expo, Tech and STEM Showcase, and Digital Navigator Trainings - there was something for everyone!

177 DEVICES DONATED

Through our Computers for Community Program, we refurbish devices for distribution in the community. We also purchase new computers through grant funding. 177 devices were given out in 2023.

3,000+ ATTENDEES

We had over 3,000 individuals attend our events in Chelan, Douglas, Grant, and Okanogan Counties.

60+ COALITION MEMBERS

We run the NCW Digital Access and Equity Coalition which is a collaborative effort involving organizations, public utilities, government agencies, community groups, and stakeholders working together to address issues related to digital access and equity in our region.

\$174K+ DONATED

Through grant funding and scholarships, over \$174,000 dollars came into our organization and back out to other non-profits, community-based organizations, scholarship recipients or startups.

\$300K+ AWARDED

The 2023 Flywheel Investment Conference awarded over \$300,000 on April 20, bringing the total to over \$1.3 million that has been awarded to Washington-based companies through the annual event.

DIGITAL EQUITY MONTH

September was Digital Equity Month, focusing on reducing digital resource access disparities in our region. Under the NCW Tech Help brand, we hosted pop-up events, trainings, and outreach, aimed to lessen the digital divide. This initiative emphasized raising awareness about digital equity and ensuring inclusive digital participation. Highlights included 12 Tech Help pop-ups, a digital skills survey completed by 470 individuals, 135 trained Digital Navigators, and a Digital Literacy Skills course in Spanish. Additionally, over 60 people engaged in the NCW Digital Access and Equity Coalition that we launched and more than 115 attended the Virtual Care Conference


FLYWHEEL CONFERENCE



GemaTEG was named the winner of the 2023 Flywheel Conference and received a \$150,000 investment award.
